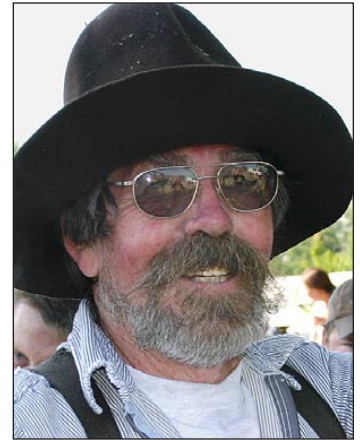
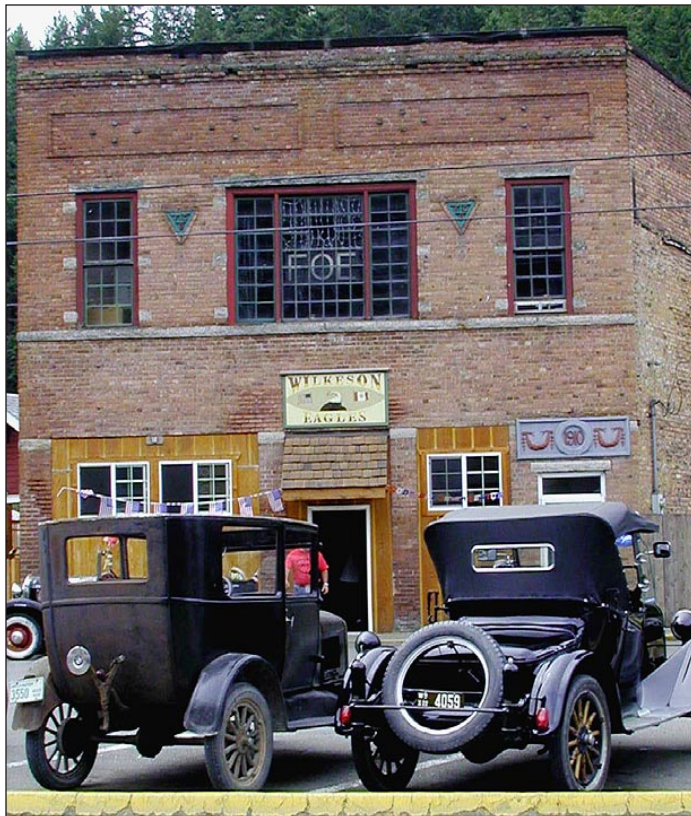


Who says you can't be old and hot, too?
